Our days are brighter from inside out as we cuddle with Mrs. Cottontail's snuggle bunnies as Christi returns with her

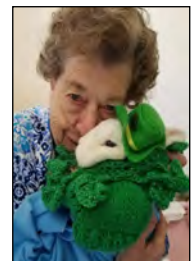


precious furry pets.

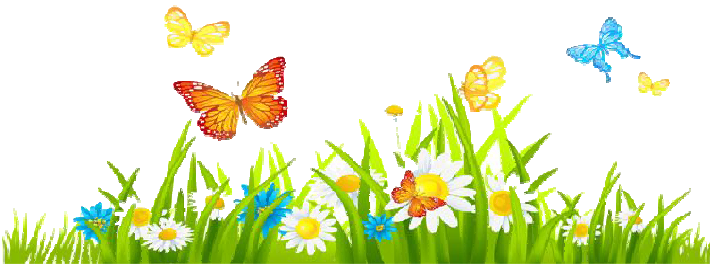

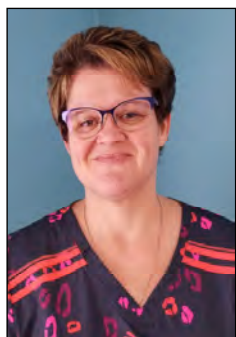

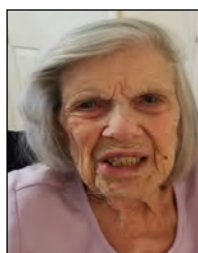
Welcome New Residents

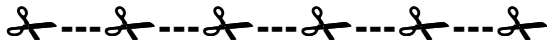

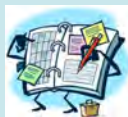
