When bringing in these items, please be sure to write names on all bathroom caddys & all toiletry items with a permanent marker. Some basic items to keep in stock are: shampoo, bodywash, lotion, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, denture cleaner, & container, electric razor or disposable razors, and shaving cream.
