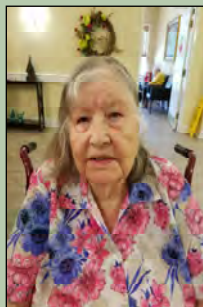

Opal Wall

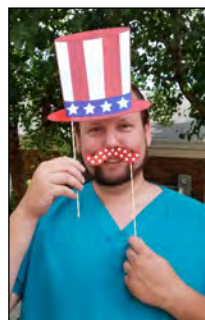

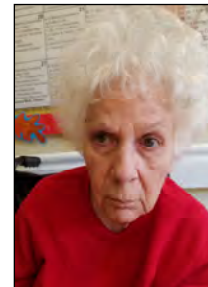

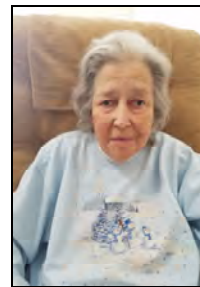
