Christine actually met her future husband and soulmate, Jack Myers in the first grade. Jack's sister and she would walk along the railroad tracks on their way to school. After their first child was born she left the phone company to raise her children. They had two beautiful children together: a son, Martin (who is now in heaven) and a daughter, Lauren. She considers her children to be her greatest accomplishment. After her children were grown, she found her passion in bookkeeping, which she enjoyed until her retirement.

Christine considers her life to have been a life of opportunities and ministry. Her first volunteer job was a listening ministry from CONTACT. She received extensive professional training and was able to help people in times of need. She counseled for over ten years in this ministry.

She later became a transportation volunteer for the Presbyterian Church Ministry. She would take people from the community to and from their doctors' appointments.

Christine attended Trinity United Methodist Church for over 75 years. She is the oldest active female member. She was the Membership Chairman and knew everyone. She also volunteered for the Food for the Bereaved Committee. She planned the meals and made sure the families had plenty to eat.

Christine was also involved in the Pictorial Directory and helped with publishing the last five directories.

She is very proud of her two grandsons, their accomplishments, and the fine young men they have become. ♥

Christine stated how blessed she has been to live such a fulfilling life filled with opportunities to help others, and wouldn't change a thing.
