Tony had a great childhood growing up. He loved playing baseball, basketball, and riding dirt bikes (that was until he got his drivers license ☺). He has always loved and grown up with animals. He had a pet duck and a horse named Toby which bit his hand when he was feeding him an apple, and of course there was always a dog ☺.

Tony had several jobs between Lowe's Foods and Walmart. He enjoyed the experience he got at Goodwill Industries.



After college, Tony moved into an apartment. It was there that he met his special friend, Kathy. ♥ While living in the apartment, Tony suffered a severe stroke and laid there for 3-4 days before his landlord found him and immediately called for help. Thank goodness Tony is a tough old bird! ☺ After months of rehab, Tony and his family began looking for the perfect place for him to call home. Thank goodness he chose Clemmons Village. ☺


