She married Thorton Perry Taliaferro on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1942 during World War II. They were married for 45 years until his passing. She had three children: Victoria, Perry, and Cathy. She went into nursing training at Roanoke Memorial Hospital after her children were grown and became a LPN. She worked as a nurse for 30 years. She was an excellent nurse and a caretaker of people and animals. She had taken care of abandoned cats all her life.

She took dancing lessons at Fred Astaire Studios where she met her second husband, Beverly Tucker. She had a blind date with him and they dated for several years before they married in 1986. She loved to dance. Beverly and she performed in front of a large audience at the Hotel Roanoke in Roanoke, Virginia. They danced together all the time and took seven or eight cruises together during their marriage. They traveled a lot together. She became a widower from this marriage in 1996.

She continues to be a member of the Ninth Street Church of the Brethren in Roanoke, Virginia, where she was an active member there.
