I believe that if he had been in any other long term care facility, that he would not have had such watchful eyes on him and the outcome would have been much different, and perhaps fatal.

Even though he has experienced some cognitive decline since experiencing the blood clots, physically he has done amazingly well. He is strong and active. He recently celebrated his 70th birthday with his siblings, daughter and granddaughter. He enjoys visits from his daughter, granddaughter, and sister on a weekly basis. I have been able to take him on car rides to Wendy's for his favorite treat, a chocolate frosty. He has continued to enjoy life, and we have enjoyed many joyous moments and memories.

In my opinion the care that ya'll gave him was superior care. The ONLY reason I decided to move him was because I realized that it was likely that he would continue to have more hospital stays in the days to come, and that it would be easier for the family to be by his side if he was closer to home. And, in fact, that has proven to be true. He was recently in the hospital for four (4) days for aspiration pneumonia. However, this time, we were able to take him to Northside Hospital where his daughter works, and it was much easier for the family to be with him. His daughter was able to visit him every day.
