Beryl enjoys reading, playing bingo, and participating in most activities.

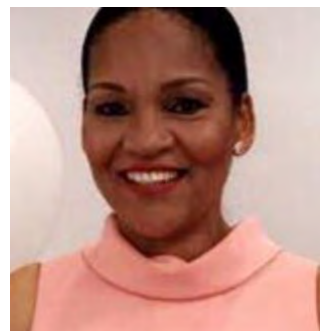
At any given time you will see her doing what she does best, and that is helping someone in need.

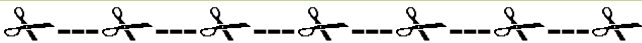
when they are in need of her help, and she is able to provide assistance is what she likes the most about her job.
